Insurance and other fees

AFL Victoria has determined that clubs affiliated with VFLW, AFL Gippsland and AFL SE will come under AFL Vic Country licensing, affiliation and insurance requirements, as follows:

Clubs affiliated with existing AFL Vic Country Senior	\$70 per team

Note: Clubs in the AFL South East or AFL Gippsland Region who are not affiliated with an existing AFL Vic Country Senior Club or a VFL Women's Club will be invoiced by AFL Victoria for their club public liability, management liability and asset protect insurance.

SFNL and EFL clubs will adopt their respective league's insurance program.

Club Charges

Clubs will be invoiced by their respective affiliated league at the start of the season.

Umpiring

Fixture

The home and away season consists of 14 Rounds for all competitions. Clubs are asked to provide their preferred day and time for their home games by 15 March. If the club has a special event and would like a home game, then they may send through a request and we'll try to accommodate it within the fixture. Preference will be given to a balance in home and away games over requests.

Any changes to days and times once the fixture is released will require approval from the opposition club, with final approval to be given by SEWF Operations Manager, following consultation with umpires.

Competitions may be assessed after Round 3 to ensure that clubs remain competitive for the remainder of the season.

Finals

There will be a three-week finals series comprising Semi Finals, Preliminary Finals and Grand Finals. Venues are to be confirmed.

Tribunals for all competitions will be conducted on a Wednesday evening at Casey Fields, Cranbourne or at Frankston Park.
